

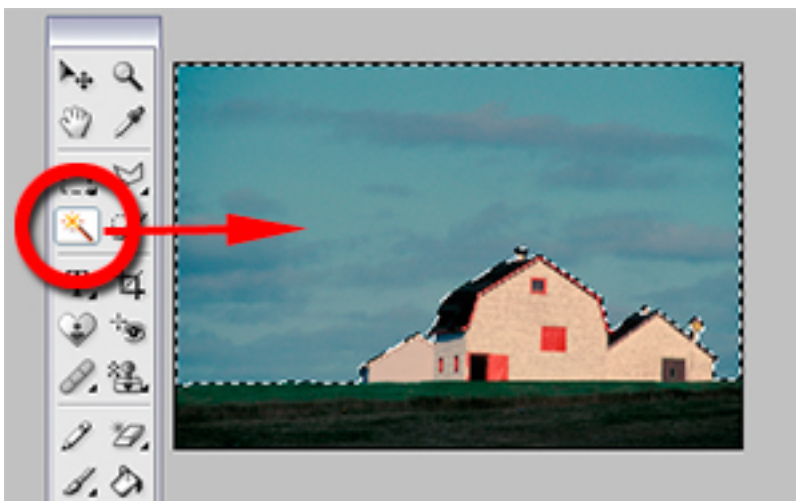
## PSE.NET Technique Tutorial



An image can be dramatically altered by replacing a sky.

### **Step by Step:**

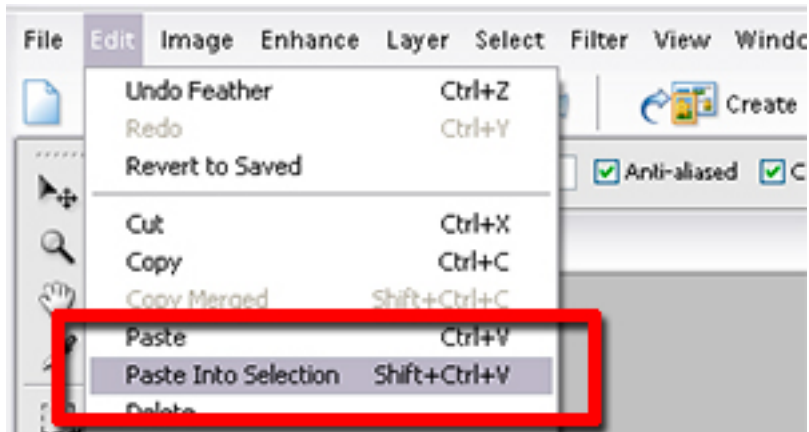
Use these steps to replace the sky in your image.



01 To replace the sky in a picture start by making a selection of just the sky. Here the Magic Wand was used to select the predominantly blue sky region.

## Adding a sky

02 Now open a substitute sky picture and make a selection of the sky. Copy the selection (Edit > Copy) and then switch back to the original picture and choose Edit > Paste Into Selection.



03 Immediately after pasting, press the Ctrl/Cmd T keystrokes combination and use the Free Transform feature to resize and adjust the proportions of the new sky to fit the area of the old.
